MASTER'S PAR 3 TOURNAMENT

Bring your friends or sign up as an individual and allow the Pros to set up pairings. The front nine will be set up as a Par 3 course in honor of the Master's Par 3 Contest. Entry fee of \$25 will cover prizes and one complimentary can beverage of your choice from the beverage cart. The scoring is individual stroke play with divisions by handicap and gender competing for prizes and bragging rights. The event will shotgun at 5:00pm with scoring in "Cliff's Court" afterward. Stop by the Golf Shop and register on the sign-up sheet.

HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE:

The committee is dedicated to achieving their goal of 100% compliance by having all JGCC Members that play Club golf events sign, date and return their Handicap Compliance Document to the Golf Shop. Families with multiple golfers that play events are required to individually submit this document. Many of our member questions about basic rules and procedures cover the same subjects. One of the more common is dropping from an immovable obstruction, such as cart paths. The proper procedure is as follows: a player has the option to take relief from his/her stance interfering with the obstruction or his/her swing while making a stroke that interferes with the obstruction. Once that option is exercised, the player must establish the nearest relief to make a stroke with full relief from the obstruction, then drop the ball within 1 club length, no nearer the hole. If the ball rolls forward or rolls more than 2 club lengths, the player must re-drop. If the ball then rolls forward or more than 2 club lengths, the player must place the ball at the point the ball hits the ground. **Note:** remember when taking relief from an obstruction, the player is ONLY to be concerned with procedures and relief from the obstruction, no consideration shall be given to a tree, bush or anything that may interfere with the next stroke.

Aeration scheduled for the course and all practice facilities will be Monday, May 14th-Monday, May 21st for wall-to-wall maintenance. The Golf Shop will be open with a reduced schedule focusing on merchandise sales and arranging tee times with other local venues per request from golf members. Please do your best to have all names in your respective groups when you submit your requests. Most of the venues allow up to 3-day advance bookings. Every effort will be made to secure the best rates available and the venue of your choice based on availability.

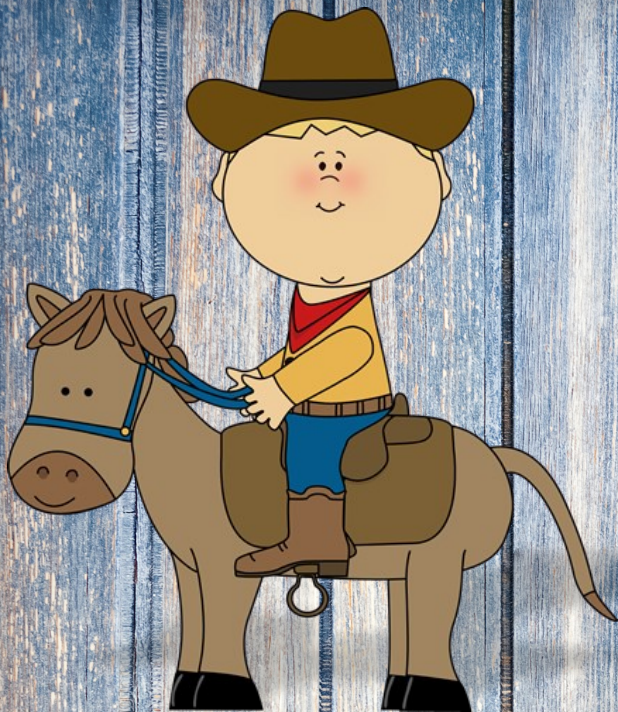
