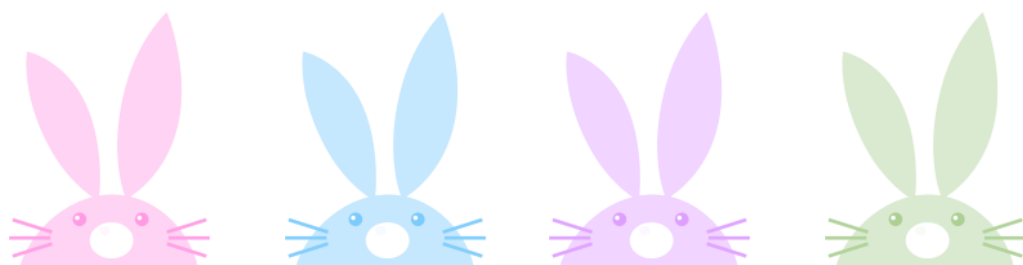

Notes from the Pro: Ray Barr

The course and all practice facilities will be closed May 11th-18th during which time the professional staff will be arranging tee times with other local venues per request from our golfing members. Please do your best to have all the names of your group when you submit your request. Most of the venues allow up to 3-day advance bookings. Every effort will be made to secure the best rates available and the venue of your choice based on availability.

Match Play Rules Reminders

Many of our members participate in the Ladies / Men's Singles / Men's 2-Man match play events. Here are some basic and simplified rules to follow during your matches as well as a reference to Rule 2 of the USGA Rules of Golf:

- A match consists of one "side" playing against another with scoring determined by the number of holes won during a stipulated round
- Common terms of a match are: holes up, all square, holes down and dormie. Dormie occurs when a player is up as many holes that remain in the match.
- Player may concede the match during or before any match, a hole during or before the play of that hole or an opponent's next stroke once the opponent's ball is at rest. Making a claim on a dispute or doubt to procedure during the match must be made in a timely manner before teeing off on the next hole or, if on the last hole of the match, before players leave the putting surface. Remember: in match play players may not play a 2nd ball in any situation but must make a claim in order to continue the match. These are some basic reminders during your match play games that will hopefully assist your play and make the matches more enjoyable.
