## BEGINNING GOLFER & SHORT-GAME CLINICS

The clinic fee of \$99 per person covers up to 5 1-hour short-game lessons offering a variety of shots around our Short-Game Practice Facility to help improve your up-and-down percentages. ### HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE:

The topic of rule procedures for the month addresses rule 28 "Ball Unplayable." Golfers are permitted to declare their golf ball unplayable anywhere on the golf course, except in a water hazard. There are spots on JGCC where hazards do not contain water; however, these areas (hole #4) remain within a hazard. A ball can be declared unplayable in a "bunker"; however, the ball must remain in the bunker when dropped.

#### Relief options under penalty of 1-stroke:

- 1) Proceed under stroke and distance playing the ball from as near as possible from which the original ball was played.
- 2) Drop a ball within 2 club lengths from the original spot where the ball lay, no nearer to the hole.
- 3) Or, drop a ball behind the point where the ball lay, keeping that point directly between the hole and the spot on which the ball is dropped with no limit how far behind that point the ball may be dropped.

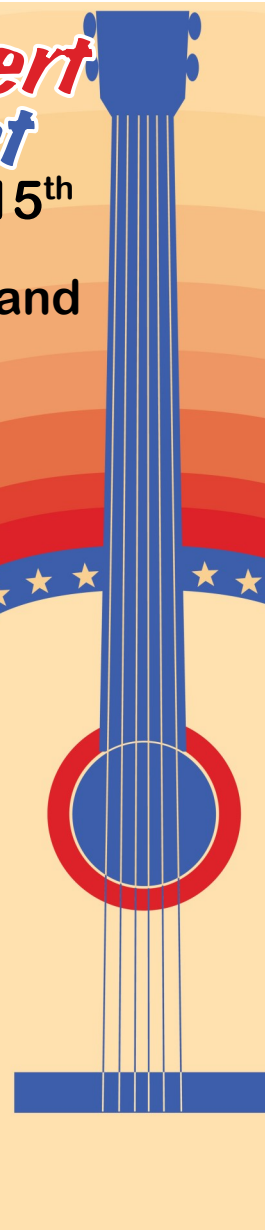
