Well, the USGA has offered some insightful statistics about how often that should occur and the odds of a golfer of a certain ability to tie or better his handicap.

Additionally, when a golfer seemingly plays better in tournament situations over his/her regular posting, the software will cause a reduction of that person's index. This process is based on a person's tournament score history, thus reflecting his/her potential as a variance from his/her index.
