HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE

The buzz around golf over the last year has been the USGA proposed rule changes taking effect in January 2019. The proposed changes that are adopted by the USGA will be included in the new edition of the rewritten Rules of Golf for 2019. It is also the understanding that there will be fewer rules (from 34 to 28) with additional simplification.

One rule that has been in effect this year, as an amendment to a current rule, is Rule 18 -2/0.5 Ball At Rest Moved. The USGA amended the rule and chose to implement this now rather than wait for the newest written version in 2019. Please visit your website at www.jaxgcc.com. 


Mr. and Mrs. Club Championship
