HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE:

One of the topics from the last meeting on May 24th was the makeup of the committee members. The committee has recently added 2 new members, Mary Rice and Tom Leddy.

The education topic for the month is hazards and boundary markers. All JGCC hazards are classified as lateral hazards identified by red stakes or red stakes with green tops and defined by red lines. All boundary (OB) markers are white poles identifying and defining the boundaries of the course. During the course of play, red lateral hazard stakes MAY be removed if they interfere from a player's stance or swing without penalty, however, boundary markers (OB stakes) are NOT allowed to be moved when interfering with a golfer's stance or swing. Often I am asked if a gate in a fence outside the boundary of the course is allowed to be opened in order to make a swing and the answer is NO. Golfers are not allowed relief from anything outside the boundary of the course or those markers.



NEW Fitness Center Teen Usage Policy

The Fitness Committee has approved a new teen usage policy that states that thirteen thru fifteen year old's may now utilize all areas of the fitness center accompanied by a parent or guardian. This policy change now allows for teens (13 years of age) to utilize the fitness facility; but only, once they have completed the mandatory Equipment Competency Test with our certified personal trainer, Dan Grimes. This test will require the 13 year old, accompanied by a parent or guardian, to be tested for competency on all of the cardio and strength machines within the fitness center, functional training facility and aerobics room.

To make an appointment for this test, please contact the fitness center at 223-9020 and we will be glad to help you coordinate with our trainer.

Effective immediately, all teens must sign the new Code of Conduct form



prior to utilizing the fitness center. Once turning 16 years of age, dependents may utilize the fitness center unaccompanied.
