### HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE:

One of the topics from the last meeting on May 24<sup>th</sup> was the makeup of the committee members. The committee has recently added 2 new members, Mary Rice and Tom Leddy.

The education topic for the month is hazards and boundary markers. All JGCC hazards are classified as lateral hazards identified by red stakes or red stakes with green tops and defined by red lines. All boundary (OB) markers are white poles identifying and defining the boundaries of the course. During the course of play, red lateral hazard stakes MAY be removed if they interfere from a player's stance or swing without penalty, however, boundary markers (OB stakes) are NOT allowed to be moved when interfering with a golfer's stance or swing. Often I am asked if a gate in a fence outside the boundary of the course is allowed to be opened in order to make a swing and the answer is NO. Golfers are not allowed relief from anything outside the boundary of the course or those markers.
