HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE:

The Committee met on June 2nd to review some important material and reminders to publish to our membership. One such topic that creates quite a bit of misunderstanding, disagreement and controversy is Section 9 of the USGA Handicap Manual: **Players competing from different Tees**. Each tee has a different course rating which reflects the probable score of a scratch golfer, thus the difference in course ratings should be rounded to the nearest whole number and added to the higher CR. In the event the higher CR has the majority of players in the field, the difference can be subtracted from the lower CR or minority of players in the event. Applying the adjustments in handicap in this situation creates an equal competition while allowing the use of different tees in the same competition. The key to understanding Section 9 is targeted to create a more equal/fair competition by players competing from essentially different courses based off CR p/tee. Hopefully this will create more clarity and understanding of Section 9.

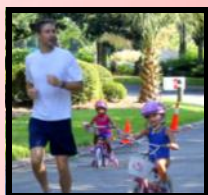
