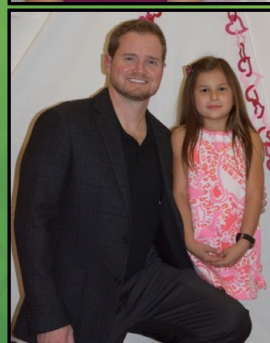

## HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Committee would like to continue to remind all golfers to post all scores (both 9 and 18-hole rounds). Additionally, they want to strongly encourage all golfers that keep a handicap record to complete and return a signed copy of the handicap compliance document found on the website. The Handicap Committee requires golfers have this signed document on file in the Golf Shop before participation in all JGCC golf events.

Golfers are also encouraged to apply ESC (equity stroke control) or the score you were most likely to have made (per the USGA), whichever is the lower of the two, for holes that you pick up or do not complete. The max score a golfer can post is listed on the board at the score posting station in the golf shop.

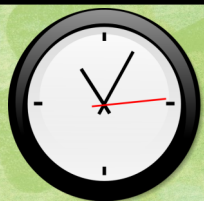

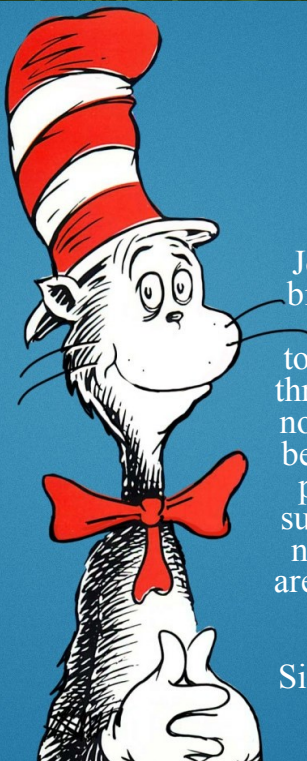
