Notes from the Pro: Ray Barn

REMINDERS FROM PRO:

- The more success we have in repairing ALL BALL MARKS and filling ALL DIVOTS keeps our course in beautiful condition for everyone!
- Please keep all 4 tires on the concrete around areens and tees.
- Please be mindful and avoid running over the small green and white posts directing cart traffic away from worn grass on curves.
- Yellow range balls, white practice balls, den caddies with range balls, and black alignment sticks are provided for all members to use only in designated areas.

HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE:

Please return your signed and completed Handicap Compliance Document ASAP! All golfers are required to have this document on file during the newly updated campaign for 2018. Copies are available on the website on the golf page or in the Golf Shop.

Members often ask or call the Golf Professionals to interpret rules from situations occurring during play. One situation that seems to reoccur is loose impediments in hazards. A majority of these situations arise from the right side of #4 fairway. Per the 2018 Rules of Golf, loose impediments are not allowed to be touched or moved within a hazard, such as pine cones, sticks, branches, etc. Man-made objects, such as cans, lids or small rocks in bunkers are allowed to be removed under no penalty. A violation of this rule will result in a two-stroke penalty.
