From the Desk of Paul Craven

Both the weather and the Club have been extremely active! And despite weather impacting the Spring Campout, the Golf Member/Member Tournament and the third consecutive major Tennis Tournament of the season, we keep moving forward!

Following a full month of activity in April, I believe May will be even busier! As you'll see within this newsletter, there is much to be excited about as we head into summer. Here are a few highlights:

On Thursday, April 30th, the Club is hosting a prospective member cocktail party. The membership has been terrific in responding to this event. There are a large number of confirmed individuals that have expressed interest in Club membership so this should be a great event. This is in addition to a number of perspective members



already signing up for our trial membership program this month. It looks like word is getting out about how good it is to be a member of JGCC!

The Players Championship week that starts May 4th tees off a couple full golf weeks at the Club. Our golf course, which is in terrific condition, will be busy with a number of members and guests playing throughout the week. Be sure to go online or call the Pro Shop to make your tee times for the week. Following the Players Championship, the course will close from May 11th through May 18th for Aerification Week. This will be our second year closing the course to allow for major work to be completed ensuring the long term condition of the course. While closed, a number of golf courses in the area have extended playing privileges for our members. Please call the Pro Shop to arrange for these playing opportunities. In addition, volunteer opportunities on the maintenance of our course are available during the week. Sign up at the Pro Shop if you'd like to help Greg and his crew out. More information on the plans on the week is posted in the Golf Pro Shop.

Having completed the resurfacing and landscape work on our pool last month, our facility improvement plans continue in May with the tennis courts. Starting May 18th, we begin stripping and regrading for the resurfacing of our original seven tennis courts. Working on two or three courts at a time, our plan is to complete this within a 20 day period (weather permitting). This will get these courts in "like new" condition with much better draining than before. Time permitting, we will also work on improving the landscaping around the courts, similar to what was completed last year.

Through the first quarter of the year, the Club is operating slightly ahead of budget. As usual a full outline of our financial results will be provided online and in your upcoming statement.

- Starting Tuesday, May 5th, weekday tee times will start at 7:30am. Men's Open Play will shotgun at 8am each Wednesday and Friday beginning Friday, May 6th. Weekends will remain the same with the first time at 8am on both #1 and #10 Tees. These times will continue through September going forward. Our Superintendant, Greg Tharp, would like to remind all our early morning golfers of our practice to allow only threesomes and foursomes each morning prior to 8am. Singles and twosomes will not be allowed to start prior to 8am. The maintenance staff cannot complete their setup of the course for the day when singles or twosomes interrupt their routine of preparing the course each morning. Thank you for your cooperation.
- Adopt-A-Hole program continues to be important to our course conditions and hopefully remains active with all of our golfers. Please check with our starter each time you play the course and take a little extra special care of <u>your hole for the day!</u> The more success we have in repairing ALL BALL MARKS and filling ALL DIVOTS keeps our course in beautiful condition for everyone!
- Additionally, please adhere to the **CART PATH ONLY** designation when in effect! The excellent condition of our facility can only be maintained with the support of our golfers!
- Handicap Flags are allowed on the course with a doctor's note permitting members to drive their carts closer than normal to the greens. Those utilizing handicap flags are reminded to stay on the flat areas below bunkers and the greens. Please do not drive your carts near the green surfaces or between any greenside bunkers. Members are also reminded that handicap flags are not allowed during cart path only conditions!
- The MGA Board recently had their request approved to allow guests of MGA members to participate in their monthly events on a limited basis. Members may invite guests on a limited basis under the following criteria: valid and current hcp index, no more than 2 times per year, member appreciation golf & green fees plus \$65 MGA tournament fee and guests will play with the member.

HANDICAP COMMITTEE UPDATE

A friendly reminder from the Committee about posting scores from 9 holes - tournament rounds. Players are urged to post all 9-hole scores and 18-hole scores from stroke play and match play rounds.

- 9-hole scores are posted when completing 7-12 holes and 18-hole scores are posted when completing a minimum of 13 holes. Players are to apply ESC (equitable stroke control) on holes not completed. See chart at handicap posting station in Golf Shop.
- Reminder that tournament scores are also subject to ESC adjustments.
- All Match Play scores are to be posted. Holes conceded or not completed during a match are to be scored with the score the player was most likely to have made in that situation! i.e.: a player picks up after losing a hole and lies 10ft from the pin ... he is most likely to have a two-putt to record a score. i.e.: a player has birdie from 35ft conceded, he would invoke a two-putt for a par on the hole.
