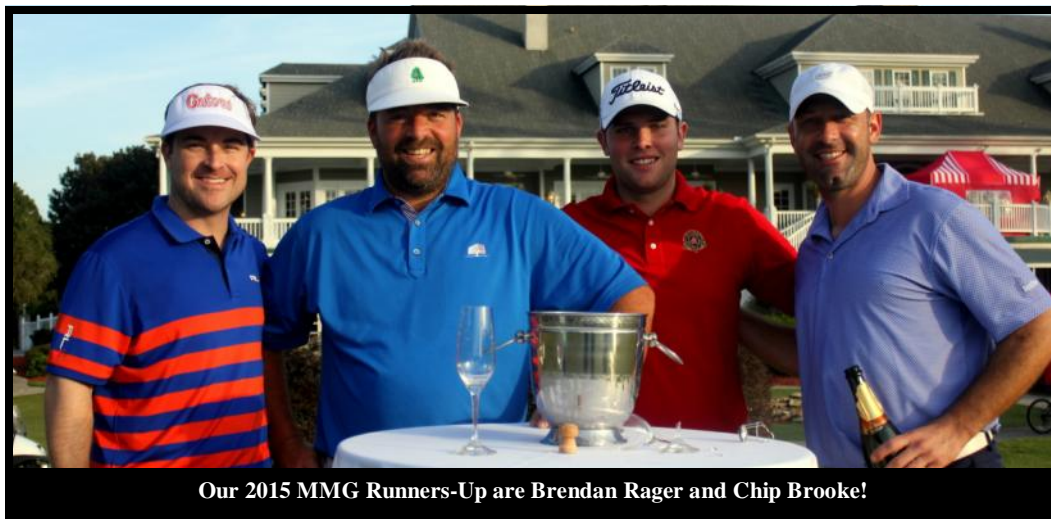

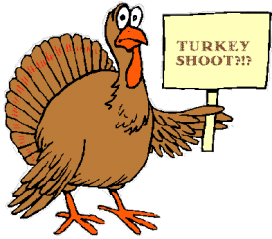

Handicap Committee Update

The word from the Committee this month is "posting actual scores" while playing in events of any kind ... Men's Lottery, E-9, Couples Golf, Gunfight, etc. If you choose to not finish a hole and apply ESC, please put an X in the box, ex: X-7. This will not count your score for a team score or an individual game such as Lottery. This is the proper way to score when a player does not finish a given hole. Another important change in the Rules of Golf that has been coming for the past 2 years is Rule 14-1b - Anchoring the Putter. As of January 1st, under the guidance of the U.S.G.A. Rules, golfers are no longer allowed to anchor their putter. The PGA of America has adopted this policy as well. The Golf Committee will review the change at their next meeting and make a decision as to how JGCC will apply this going forward and be sure to communicate to all members.
