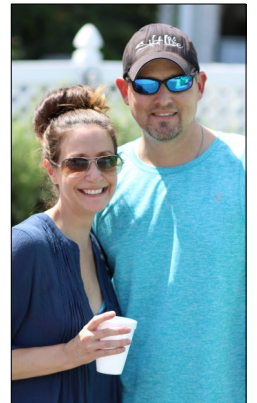

From the Desk of Paul Craven

Here we are just about to embark upon our fourth and final quarter for 2017. As such you will see the third edition of the Quarterly Newsletter from the Board of Governors providing additional information regarding committee activities and general information about the Club.

We had a great member turnout in early September to celebrate the opening of the new golf practice facility. With a new short game green, enlarged putting green, and enlarged driving range with additional target greens, your facility is one of the best Country Club practice facilities in northeast Florida! Our hope is this will attract new golf members to our Club as well.

We appreciate your patience during the closure, assessment and reopening of the Club due to hurricane Irma. Sadly, we are getting accustomed to the practice! In summary, the Club was closed for five full days with the pool and golf course closing for an additional day and a half. We lost (or will need to take down) just over fifty trees in areas including the course, driving range and around the parking lot. We had some minor damage to the restroom and major damage to the ice machine at Hole #14; and, as many of you would have seen, the netting that protects the parking lot from the short game green was badly damaged. There was also damage at the tennis courts: with a portion of the awning lost that wraps around the Tennis Pro Shop as well as having one tennis shelter totally destroyed and one severely damaged. Thanks to heavy preparation beforehand, that was about the extent of the losses. There was virtually no damage to the main Clubhouse, pool or golf course maintenance building. The pool and tennis courts sustained major debris as did the golf course. We received outstanding help from a huge group of volunteers that helped clean up the tennis courts and a number of members provided huge support removing debris off the golf course – a big thank you to all that were able to support the Club! We have received bids on all the repairs necessary and expect to have most of the work completed within a few weeks. We will have an insurance claim for both tree loss/debris removal and business interruption to offset the losses incurred.

Work will start on some minor upgrades to the Adult Bar early next month. The plan is to remove the cabinetry above the bar in an effort to open up the room, change out some lighting and upgrade the TV's. The work should take no more than a week and be ready prior the Men's Member-Guest Golf Tournament.

Speaking of the Men's Member Guest, best of luck to all of the participants entered in October's tournament. The 2017 event schedule has been changed from prior years with a practice day followed by three days of competition rather than cramming the matches and shoot-out into two days. This will be Golf Course Superintendent Nate Maurer's first member-guest and opportunity to showcase his talents with the rest of the staff and member-guest committee. Good luck to all! In addition to the Member-Guest, we also have a couple of other highly attended traditional events this month. The Oktoberfest Buffet is on the 6th and our Halloween Monster Mash takes place on the 25th. Be sure to make your reservations early as these fun events fill up fast! See you around the Club,

HANDICAP COMMITTEE

The Handicap Committee recently met and agreed to continue their focus on educating our members about the importance of posting ALL scores immediately after a round of golf. Remember to post an 18-hole round using equitable stroke control if you have completed at least 13 holes and a 9-hole round if you have completed at least 7 holes.

Additionally, the committee wants to remind everyone about the handicap adjustments necessary when golfers play different sets of tees. Each golfer’s index will convert to a handicap for a specific tee and the difference in course ratings will further adjust a player’s handicap by adding or subtracting strokes to accommodate the tees. The USGA recommends golfers playing the higher course rating receive additional strokes from those playing the lower rating tees.

As always, if you have any questions or require further explanation of this practice, please stop by the Golf Shop and the professionals will do their best to clarify the process.

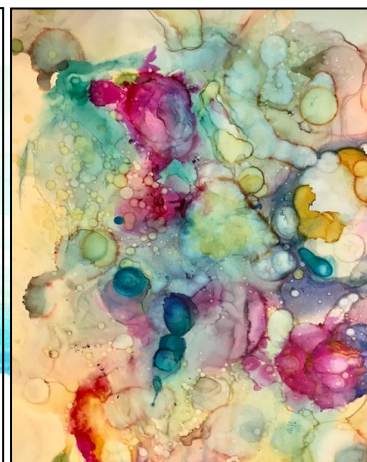

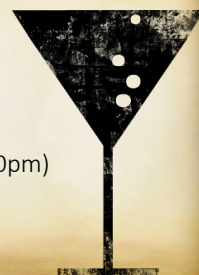
