Notes from the Pro: Ray Barr

Members are encouraged to please check in with the Golf Professional Staff prior to all golf rounds and/or use of the practice facilities. Stop by and let us know you are here or call us at 223-6910. This is not intended as an inconvenience, rather a benefit for all to know you are here in the event of an emergency.

Golfers are reminded to please keep all golf cart tires on the cart paths around all greens, tee areas, and driving range parking! You are also reminded to repair your ball mark and one other on each green.

HANDICAP COMMITTEE

In the event you have multiple active handicap records, please call the Golf Professionals for assistance. The USGA requires the lowest index of multiple records is the one that is valid and must be used. If you have multiple records within the same system, i.e., GolfNet or GHIN, those records can be merged to allow any and all scores posted to both records simultaneously.

Most golfers have active phone apps allowing you to post and review yours and your buddies' handicap index information. Your app is tied to your primary index record; and, when merged within the same system, your scores are reflected in each record.

Golfers are reminded to post all scores (9 and 18-hole) in the timeliest manner. Posting all scores the day they are played is the most beneficial procedure, especially immediately preceding the revision of handicaps for that two-week period.

BEGINNING GOLFER & SHORT-GAME CLINICS

The beginning golfer clinics kick off with a clinic by the Professional staff on Saturday, September 2, 10-11am. Attend as many of the five clinics as you would like for \$99. The one-hour clinics run for five weeks September 2 – 30. The sign-up sheet is in the Golf Shop.

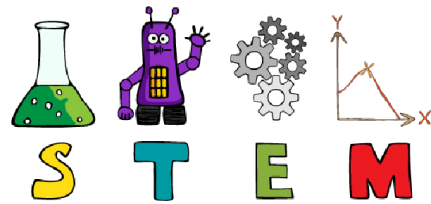

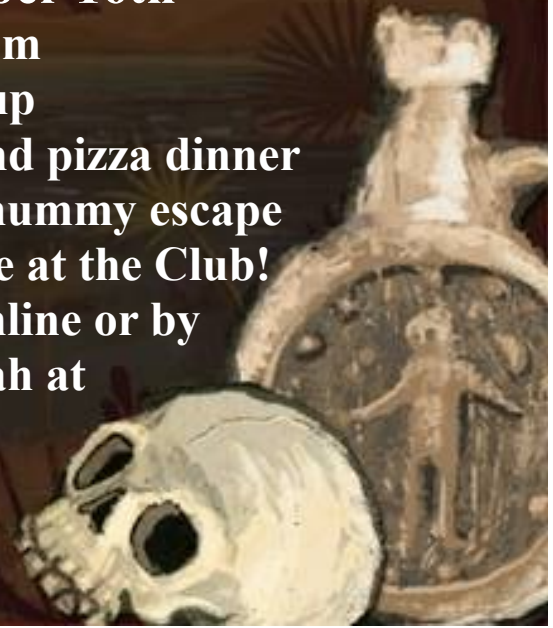
