Handicap Committee: GHIN Conversion and Loose Impediments

Most of our Members are aware of the change and conversion from GolfNet to GHIN for our handicap recording service. If you have not received your new GHIN ID#, please call the Golf Shop at 223-6910 or go to www.jaxgcc.com on the Golf Page to find the entire list and the link to the USGA Mobile App for the convenience of recording from your mobile phone.

The rule topic of the month covers Loose Impediments.

Loose impediments are defined by "natural objects" including stones, leaves, twigs, branches and the like, dung, worms, insects and the like and casts and heaps made by them, as long as they are not attached, fixed or growing, solidly embedded or adhering to the ball. Sand and loose soil are loose impediments only on the putting surface. Example: sand on the fringe of the green when a ball is off the putting surface is not loose impediment and removal of the sand will result in a penalty.

Knowing the Rules of Golf can be a benefit to all golfers and not knowing the basic of rules can lead to penalties and/or disqualifications.

In the coming months, be on the watch for communication about rules sessions at JGCC discussing the 2019 USGA Rules of Golf, specifically the major changes with the Rule Book and adoption of New Rules.

Fitness Center Teen Usage Policy

Teens, 13 years of age, may utilize the fitness facility accompanied by a parent or guardian; but only, once they have completed the mandatory Equipment Competency Test with one of our certified personal trainers and have also filled out the Code of Conduct Form prior to utilization. The Equipment Competency Test is designed to test each dependent on their competency on all of the cardio and strength machines within the Fitness Center, Functional Training Facility and Aerobics Room. During this test, the 13 year old is required to be accompanied by a parent or guardian. An appointment for this test can be made by calling the Fitness Center at 223-9020.

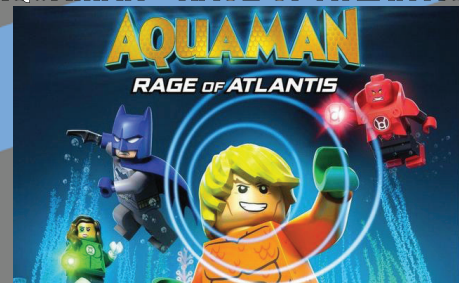
